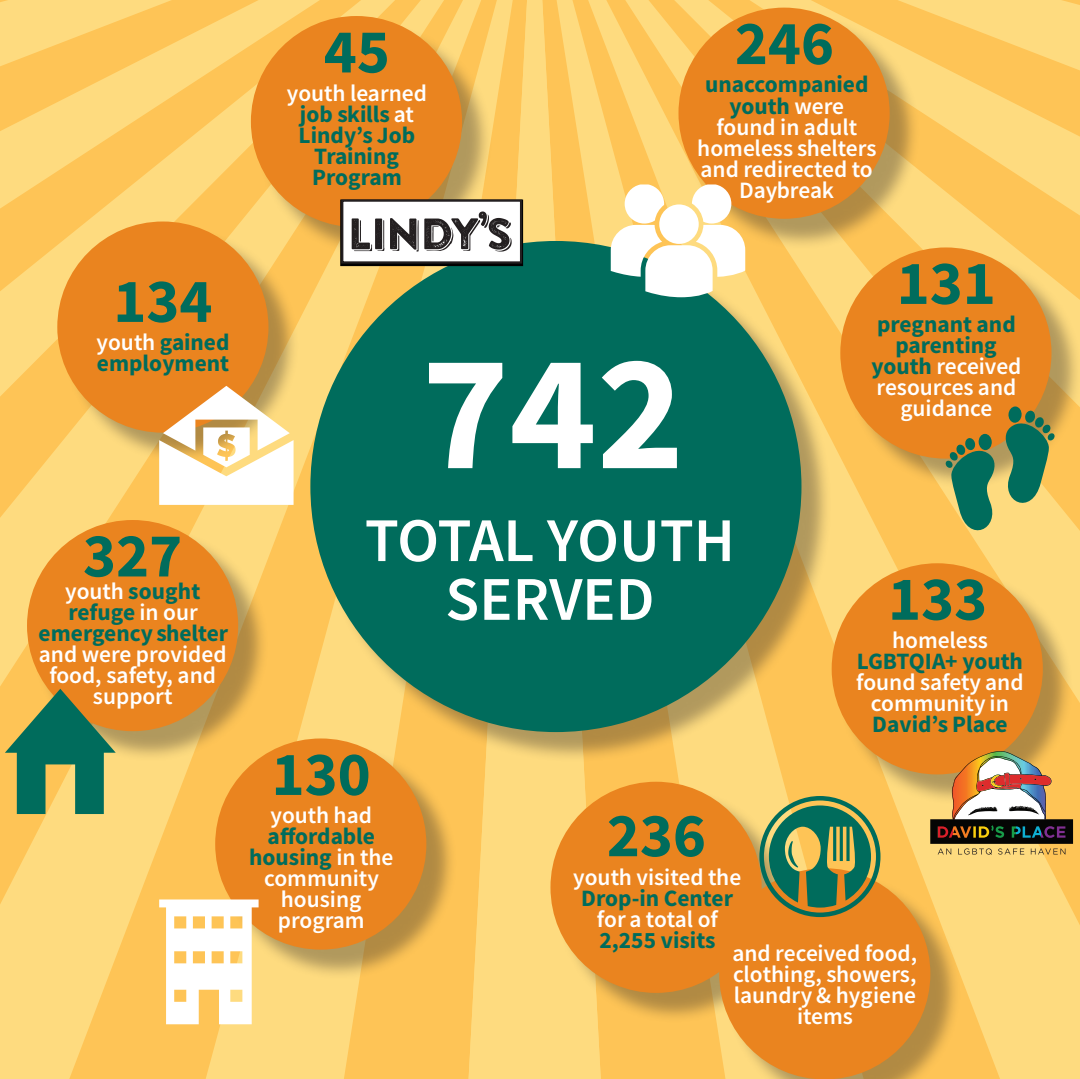

have been neglected or abused

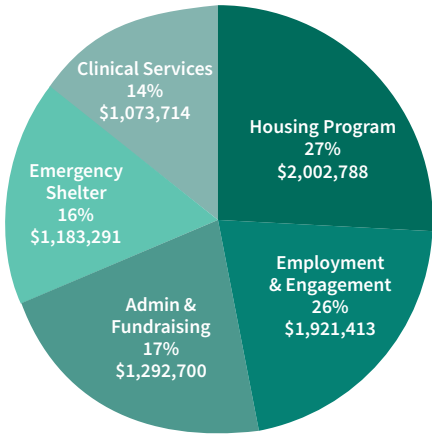
**5 out of 10**
